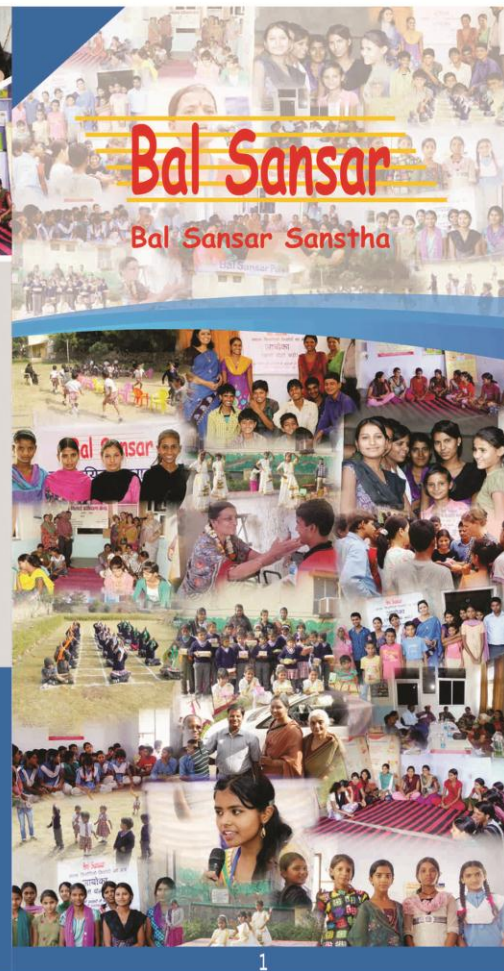

Current Projects

Sambal Skill and Entrepreneurship Development Institute (SEDI) for the rural youth in Ajmer district, since April 2013. The Project Goal: SEDI aims to address the skill building needs of rural women and youth for their overall development, livelihood and quality survival. This will help rural youth to live their lives with respect and dignity while exploring their fullest potentials in life. To initiate with, the activities of this institute will take place in Ajmer district. Currently, computer education, photography classes and sewing courses are initiated. Since Nov.2015, BSS has been approved as a registered IT training centre by the Rajasthan Knowledge Corporation Ltd. (RKCL), GoR <http://rkl.in> for running two courses namely RS-CIT (Rajasthan State Certificate Course in Information Technology) and RS-CFA (Rajasthan State Certificate Course in Financial Accounting). About 100 Trainees are enrolled in SEDI at any point of time.

Bal Sansar Public School (BSPS) in Ajmer since April 2013: BSFS aims to provide quality education to the children from 2+years, i.e. play group to the senior secondary level; enabling them to claim equal development and growth opportunities in their lives.

Our pre-school education is a school readiness programme with the development of multiple intelligences among children while introducing the age appropriate physical and life-skill activities, cognitive training of senses and creativity sessions with the children. The Primary school till 5th standard is approved by the Govt. of Rajasthan in July 2014 and current session has enrolled 100 kids from the surrounding villages. Most of these kids come from humble background; 80 percent parents are engaged in daily wage earnings as laborers with poor paying capacity.

Accomplished Projects

'Taiyari', a demonstration model for planned transitions from adolescence to adulthood: in Partnership of Community, BSS and UNICEF, in Tonk & Ajmer districts (May 2013-August 2015).

Project Goal: To improve the quality of life of adolescents by introducing strategies for planned transitions from adolescence to adulthood. To achieve this goal, specific objectives, strategies, activities and a result framework was designed. Coverage: 30 Gram Panchayats from 2 blocks of Ajmer and Tonk. districts of Rajasthan.

Beneficiary: Direct - 1800 adolescents (900 boys & 900 Girls); **Indirect:** 20,000 adolescents.

These empowered adolescents are inspired by the mantra **'JaBoKa'** ('Jano' 'Bolo' 'Karo')

to 'Convert the Challenges in to the Opportunities' while seeking local solutions

'Jano' = Know
 'Bolo' = Speak Out
 'Karo' = Act



Composite Target Interventions (TI): in Tonk district, since March 2011 and in Dungarpur from March 2014 to 2015. Project Goal: To control the spread of HIV by reaching out to high risk groups & linking them with the HIV prevention/health services & social protection schemes.

Coverage: Mapped locations/hotspots in Tonk and Dungarpur districts.

Beneficiary: Direct: 3000 Female Sex Workers (FSW), 500 Men having Sex with Men (MSM) Indirect: About 15000 Family and community members. / stakeholders.

Sneh Sansar: since June 2008-July 2014 in Ajmer. Project Goal: To provide safe shelter, education, food and health services, enabling them to lead a life with dignity. 'Sneh Sansar' is a Hindi word that literally translates to 'loving World', A Home Away from Home for the children orphaned. Registered under THE JUVENILE JUSTICE (CARE AND PROTECTION OF CHILDREN) ACT 2000 and valid till April 2017. Sneh Sansar was financially supported by the individual donors and friends. **Beneficiary:** 16 children.

Sambal Community Care Centre (CCC), From June 2008 to March 2013: Project Goal: To serve as a link between the HIV health facilities and People Living with HIV and affected by AIDS (PLHIV). Sambal was a 10 bedded CCC in a 10000 sq yard campus, providing counseling, treatment, rejuvenation to PLHIV during 4-5 day stay at CCC.

Coverage: Ajmer district. **Beneficiary:** 2253 PLHIV and their families.

Community Mobilization for HIV-AIDS Awareness and Prevention 'Bali Boli Project', From August 2009 to April 2010: Fifty Two episodes broadcasted on community radio resulting into the enhanced level of awareness on HIV-AIDS & STI, amongst rural women, covering an audience of 14670 club members plus 3068 other women & girls.

Awareness Generation Programme (AGP) - From Feb. 2009 to March 2010, trained 169 rural poor women in Ajmer

Networking and Capacity Building support to CSOs and CBOs: since 2006 we support, network, strengthen and hand-hold with likeminded partners who believe in the importance and need of joint efforts to bring about a positive change and an impact.
