With all the conflicts and epidemics in our current society, many children, women and old-aged are left without families, care and hope. Bal Sansar strives to offer them the dignity, care and love they need and deserve.

During the past 25 years, through partaking in prestigious education, HIV-AIDS projects, I got the opportunity to travel widely and interact closely with the most vulnerable and marginalized groups and the individuals living with HIV in our society.
